胡卡博士簡介

胡卡博士為香港註冊中醫。1982年畢業於廣州中醫藥大學醫療系，1985年畢業於該校研究生院，獲頒中西結合免疫學碩士學位。自2001年起，深入研究中醫藥於腫瘤骨轉移的臨床療效，並於2006年獲頒香港中文大學博士學位。

胡博士長期從事中醫臨床、教學和研究工作，曾先後在廣州中醫藥大學、香港大學、香港浸會大學、香港中文大學、香港理工大學任教和研究，對多種慢性病和疑難病有深入的認識和豐富的臨床經驗，精於體質調理身體機能，婦兒保健和慢性病的中醫和針灸療法。

Dr. Kalina Wu graduated from the Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine in 1982. She obtained her master's degree specializing in integrated Chinese and Western immunology from the same university in 1985. In 2006, Dr. Wu was further awarded with a Ph.D. degree at the Chinese University of Hong Kong after dedicating five years of research and clinical studies in the assessment of Chinese medicinal treatment for patients suffering from bone cancers.

As a registered Chinese medicine doctor, Dr. Wu has extensive experiences in teaching, research and professional practice. Over the years, she has held various academic and research positions at Guangzhou University of Chinese Medicine, University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong Baptist University, The Chinese University of Hong Kong and The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Dr. Wu is a TCM expert in chronic illness, holistic homeostasis, women and children health care through medicinal and acupunctural treatments.
