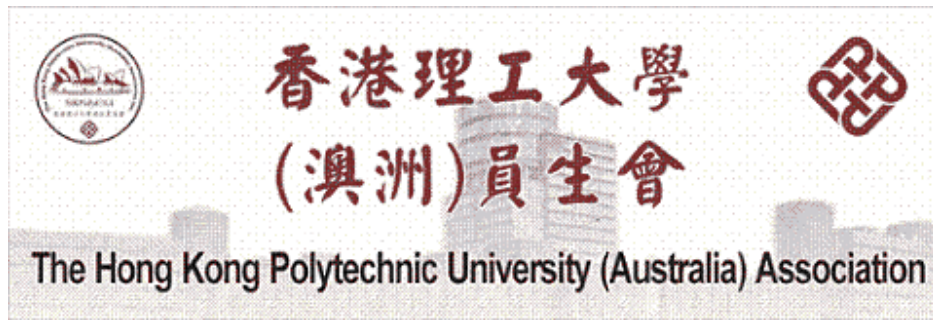


President Prof. Poon Chung-kwong's Sichuan earthquake appeal has raised HK\$3.2 million

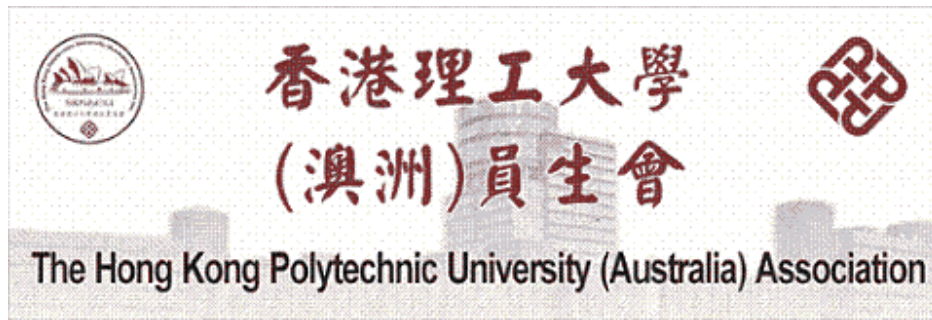
- 8.0-magnitude quake on Richter scale

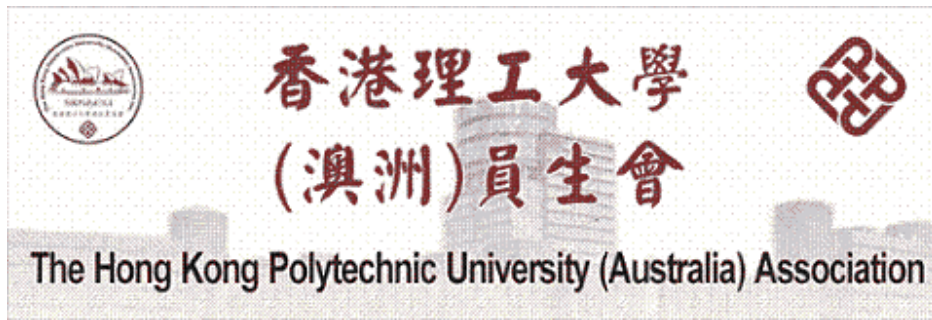


Motivators of our China earthquake appeal

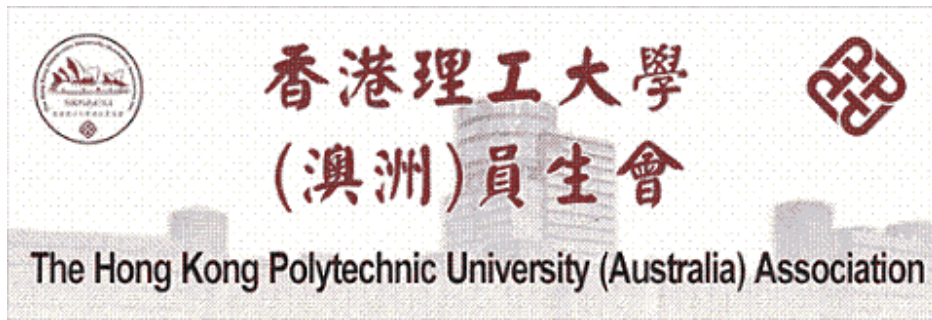

Left: Speaker Karina So – Clinical Consultant Nurse of Concord Hospital spoke on ‘Common Urological Conditions and Problems’.

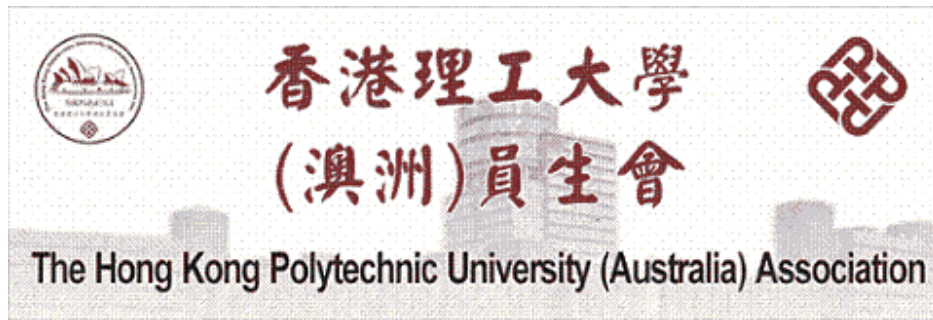
Her presentation covered many topics in a fun way and gave much practical knowledge to the dinner participants.
