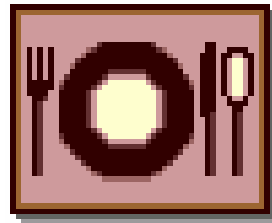

“The Council of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU) [on] 21 April announced the appointment of Prof. Timothy W. Tong, currently Dean of School of Engineering and Applied Science (SEAS) at the George Washington University in the United States, as its new President with effect from 1 January 2009. Prof. Tong will succeed Prof. Poon Chung-kwong who will be retiring from the Presidency at the end of the year after completing 18 years of distinguished service at PolyU.

Prof. Tong was born and raised in Hong Kong. After completing his secondary education at Christian College, he pursued further studies in the United States where he received his B.S degree in Mechanical Engineering from Oregon State University in 1976; M.S. and PhD in the same discipline from the University of California at Berkeley in 1978 and 1980. He completed his doctoral study under the supervision of the late prominent educator Prof. Tien Chang-lin.”
