這次筵餐本會榮幸地請到兩位知名人士作專題 演講，首先有殷國江胸肺及睡眠專科醫生主講睡眠窒息症的成因及治療方法，另一位講者是會員兼新任香港中文大學澳洲校友會會長張繼沛先生，他在雪梨創辦澳洲太極 藝文協會又教授太極多年，今次將介紹太極的精萃及其對健康和長壽的好處，並附以太極招式示範。

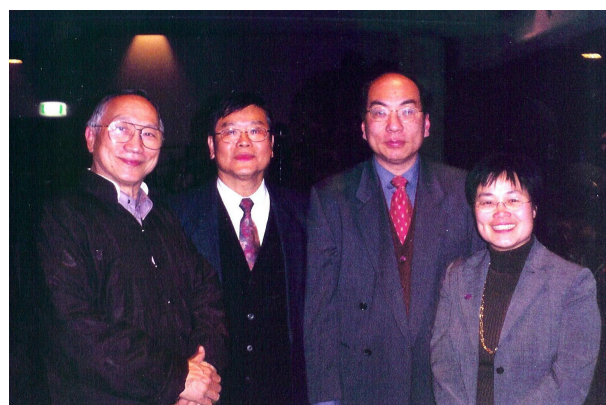
