Guolin Qigong

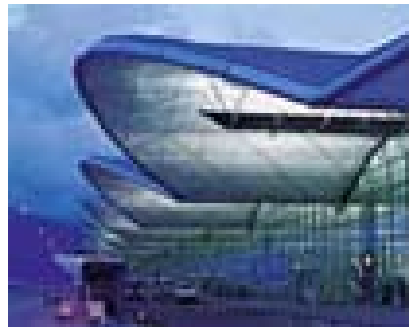
